Committee Goals:

- Goal #1:** Assist in the publishing process of the new Journal of Outdoor Recreation, Education, and Leadership (JOREL)
 Send out quarterly announcements regarding JOREL via various listservs (e.g., AORE, SPRENet), and other organizations (e.g., AEE, WEA, NRPA, NIRSA)
 Assist as Reviewers as identified and needed per the request of the Editor
- Goal #2:** Continue to host the AORE Research Symposium
 Consult with the Presenter Relations committee to ensure that research-based presentations are encouraged to submit to the Research Symposium
 Promote the Symposium via the AORE listserv and Newsletter (at a minimum in the issue previous to the Conference)
 Promote the Symposium onsite at the conference via a display poster outside the room it will be hosted in
- Goal #3:** Clearly articulate to the membership how our committee can assist their everyday efforts through research, literature reviews, presentation assistance, and publication outlets
 Develop resources through the AORE website that allow members to submit requests for assistance
- Goal #4:** Publish a "Research Update" in at least two issues of the AORE Newsletter each year that highlights "in brief" 3-5 research studies relevant to the membership and profession
- Goal #5:** Continue to coordinate the publishing of the annual Proceedings
 Place all abstracts from Research Symposium and Educational Session Presentation Descriptions from conference in Proceedings

 Continue partnership with EBSCO Host to archive Proceedings

 Request additional funding through BOD to provide a registration scholarship for the winner to attend the conference on an "as needed" basis
